Purpose: Conduct 700 free cataract surgeries, and various other activities

Summary

Our ongoing collaboration with Trilochan Netralaya on location in Odisha, India is moving on well. Between 2014 and Mid-2015, we have conducted 1350 free cataract surgeries and have helped with various trainings and skill upgrades at Sambalpur. We continue this work with 2 more mission trips scheduled in the period of October and December this year. This would include conducting another 700 free cataract surgeries, continuing the "continuing medical education" program we set up and running clinics for complicated cases.

The Vision Mission is a Singapore-based Non-Profit Organization started by Doctors and Professionals, with the purpose of providing free eve care to those in need in Southeast and South Asia. Executive Summary

Sambalpur is a remote location in the state of Odisha in India. Through 2014, The Vision Mission organized 3 mission trips (February, November, December) in this location to conduct 1000 free cataract surgeries across multiple camps in each trip. Following up from our very successful year, we wished to expand our activities in Odisha by providing other value additions, apart from continuing our work in conducting free cataract eye



surgeries, in 2015. The first of our mission trips for this year, 2015, was in March, during which we conducted 350 free cataract surgeries, established an inaugural continuing medical education program (CME), introduced retinal laser services and got another team from Beyond Eye Care to help us with systems optimization of our partner institute, Trilochan Netralaya (TN) Hospital in Sambalpur, Orissa. TN has been our partner through 2014 and we intend to continue this partnership to develop the local team into a self-sustaining model of quality eye care for the needy in the region.



Overseas Partner

Trilochan Nethralaya (TN) is an eyecare institution based in Sambalpur, Odisha, India, whose main aim is to alleviate treatable blindness in amongst underprivileged communities in the rural and poor areas of the state. The team managed by Dr Shivaprasad Sahoo has thus far conducted in excess of 60000 cataract surgeries since 2009 and have been working with TVM to create a self-sustainable eye care program for the region and beyond.

3. Follow up on basic Ophthalmic laser procedures

To follow up with Dr Shiva's team with regards of the use of ophthalmic laser procedures including retinal panretinal photocoagulation, focal laser, laser peripheral iridotomy and YAG capsulotomy.

4. Perform cataract surgeries



650 more cataract surgeries will be performed by the local team in collaboration with The Vision Mission team mainly using the SICS technique so that we will continue our annual commitment of restoring sight to 1000 individuals in need in Western Odisha.

5. Continuing Medical Education

Continue the TN-TVM CME program that was initiated during the March trip.

Costing for the Project

- Funding (in SGD) for each one-week mission trip by 2 international doctors to perform 650 cataract surgeries and review other patients and facilities in the TVM Vision Clinics to be in collaboration with Trilochan Netralaya in Odisha
 - 2 Mission Trips
 - 2 Vision Clinics per Trip
 - Surgery, Medication, Patient accommodation, Food : \$22750 (at \$\$35 per patient times 650 surgeries)
 - Travel and Accommodation costs of Doctors and Personnel from Singapore: \$8,000 (\$1,000 per person 4 persons times 2 trips)
 - TOTAL: \$30,750
