Purpose: Conduct 2000 free cataract surgeries, and various other activities

Summary

The Vision Mission has been working with Trilochan Netralaya since 2014. Over this period, we have sponsored 1000 free surgeries each year, helped with Clinics, setting up Teleophthalmology, Optometry and Refraction Training, Glaucoma Training, Surgical Process Optimization, Laser Training, Oculoplastics, setup of a Diabetic Retinopathy program, and the Continual Medical Education series. In 2017, we wish to increase the level of our engagement. We will be sponsoring 2000 free cataract surgeries. Our mission trip will be scheduled for the November/December period, where we will continue with the above programs, along with an expanded scope CME.

The Vision Mission is a Singapore-based Non-Profit Organization started by Doctors and Professionals, with the purpose of providing free eye care to those in need in Southeast and South Asia. We seek to serve as a conduit enabling transnational collaboration dedicated ophthalmic experts in providing free high quality eye care and surgery to patients in areas of need, with a view to eradicate treatable vision impairment and allow eye care access to all. Executive Summary

Sambalpur is a remote location in the state of Odisha in India. The Vision Mission (TVM) started Project Netra in 2014 in collaboration with Trilochan Netralaya (TN) at Sambalpur with the aim of providing high-quality eye care to those in need in the region. Since 2014, TVM organized 1000 free cataract surgeries for the needy per year through 2016. In addition, since 2015 we expanded our activities in Odisha by providing other value



additions - we established a continuing medical education program (CME) for ophthalmologists in the region, did formal optometry training for the technicians at TN, introduced retinal and glaucoma laser services and got another team from Beyond Eye Care to help us with systems optimization of TN Hospital in Sambalpur, Orissa. TN has been our partner through 2014 and we intend to continue this partnership to develop the local team into a self-sustaining model of quality eye care for the needy in the region by 2020.

Overseas Partner

Trilochan Nethralaya (TN) is an eyecare institution based in Sambalpur, Odisha, India, whose main aim is to alleviate treatable blindness in amongst underprivileged communities in the rural and poor areas of the state. The team managed by Dr Shivaprasad Sahoo has thus far conducted in excess of 60000 cataract surgeries since 2009 and have been working with TVM to create a self-sustainable eye care program for the region and beyond.




Objective for Project Netra 2017

1. Cataract surgeries

2000
Free Cataract surgeries

2000 more cataract surgeries will be performed by the local team in collaboration with The Vision Mission team mainly using the SICS technique so that we will continue our annual commitment of restoring sight to individuals in need in Western Odisha.



Note on Surgery Cost: We have increased the cost of surgery from the previous \$35 in order to cater for several best-practices and improvements that we have brought in with the local team at TN.

2. Continuing Medical Education

To continue and enhance the CME program that we have been running since 2015. This time we will be conducting the CME program at a larger location in Bhubaneswar, and inviting a larger audience from the state of Odisha and beyond.

3. Management Consultancy

A large part of running a tertiary medical centre and helping people in need also involves standard business management issues such as hiring people, retaining people, managing cost, branding, outreach and so on. We wish to bring in our members' management expertise and background to help TN with management related issues.

4. Follow up on Ophthalmic laser procedures, Diabetic Retinopathy, Clinics

To follow up with Dr Shiva's team with regards of the use of ophthalmic laser procedures including retinal panretinal photocoagulation, focal laser, laser peripheral iridotomy and YAG capsulotomy; procedure with respect to Diabetic Retinopathy and use of argon laser, and other matters as required.

5. Clinics

Clinical review and opinion by our team of complicated cases brought in by Dr Shiva's team.

6. Public health and epidemiology research

This year we plan to bring in experts from Singapore and the USA (Johns Hopkins) to start basic public health and epidemiological work in Odisha. Setting this research partnership would enable TVM and health authorities to better understand the exact nature and extent of the ophthalmic problems afflicting the populace, to help with subsequent health delivery initiatives.

Costing for the Project

- ◆ Funding (in SGD) for a ten-day mission trip by 4 volunteers with the aim of performing **2000 cataract surgeries** and reviewing of patients and facilities in the **TVM Vision Clinics**, in collaboration with **Trilochan Netralaya** in Odisha
 - \$85,000.00. Surgery, Medication, Patient accommodation, Food (at S\$42.5 per patient times 2000 surgeries)
 - \$4,000.00. Travel and Accommodation costs of Doctors and Personnel from Singapore and the USA: (\$1,000 per person 4 persons)

GRAND TOTAL: \$89,000.00
