Dear Dr Jayant,

It's my pleasure to invite you along with your team to conduct a free eye check up camp in my hospital in 1st half of Feb 2014. The camp will attend to poor patients for a free eye check up and the patients screened for operable cataract will be taken up for surgery in the day following. If possible, please try to bring one glaucoma surgeon in your team to treat these patients, in case they need a surgical intervention.

Sambalpur is a very poor district in the western part of Odisha. With a population little more than 1.5 million, it does not have a descent eye hospital. The govt hospital which is in the district does mere screening of patients and prescription of glasses. After the establishment of Trilochan Netralaya in 2009, poor people suffering from cataract have benefited a lot. But lack of funds and proper logistics has all the time been barrier to large scale implementation of any such program. Time and again, we have collaborated with philanthropic organisation within India and abroad too to continue our mission work. Your supports in this mission work will strength our effort one step ahead.

Please consider this request seriously and plan for a mission trip with possible financial support. Your small support will help cure hundreds of poor blind patients. Hope, you will consider this request kind heartedly.
